HOW DO YOU CATCH IT?

WHERE DOES IT GO?

Health Centre → Hospital → Aldi (in Cromwell Park entrance) → Co-op (by Funeral Parlour) → Top School (for Leisure Centre) → Walterbush Rd → Costcutter → Churchill Rd → West St, Bus Stop A → New St → Dunstan Avenue → Lewis Rd → Owen Mumford → (optional Southerndown Care Home drop-off) → New St → West St, Bus Stop B → Co-op (in delivery bay) → (optional Aldi & Marlborough Rd drop-off) → Health Centre.

WHEN DOES IT GO?

Every hour, 9am to 5pm Mon-Fri.
